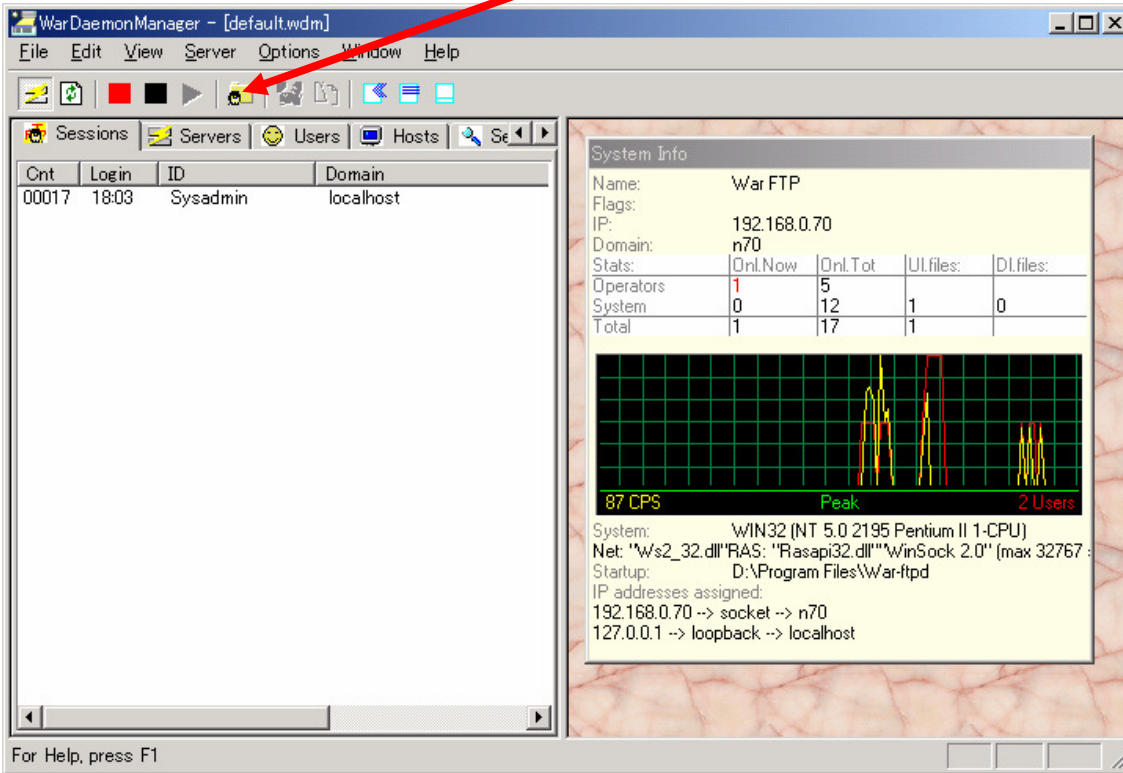


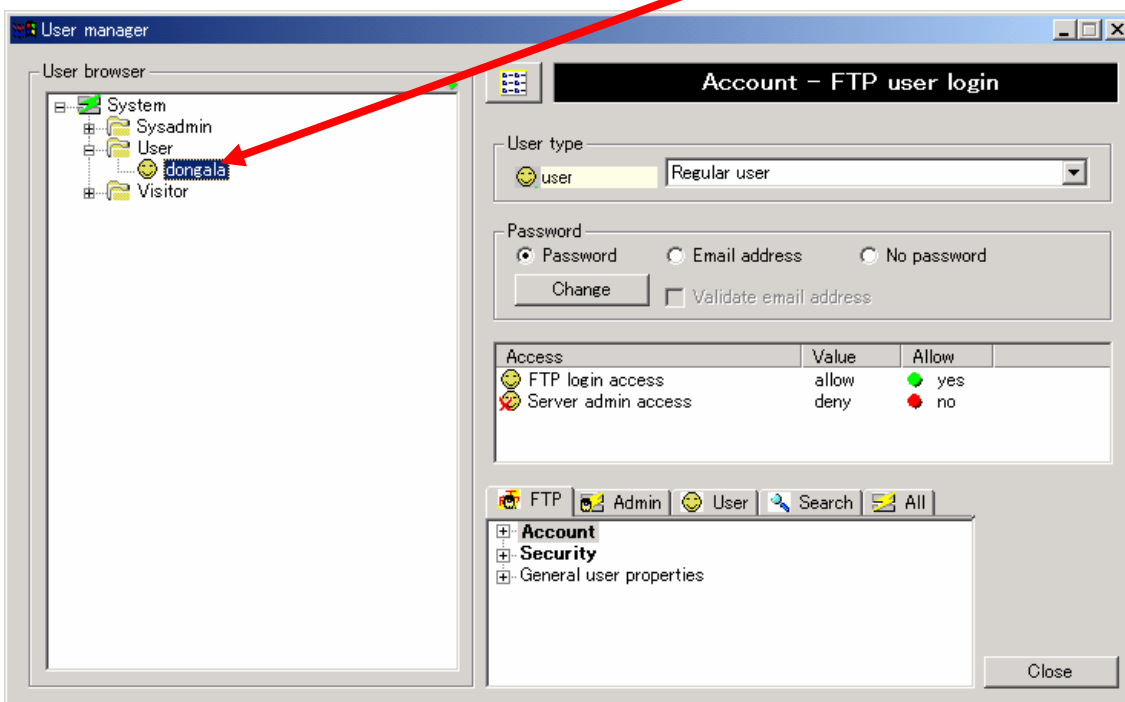
# WarFTP

Click here.

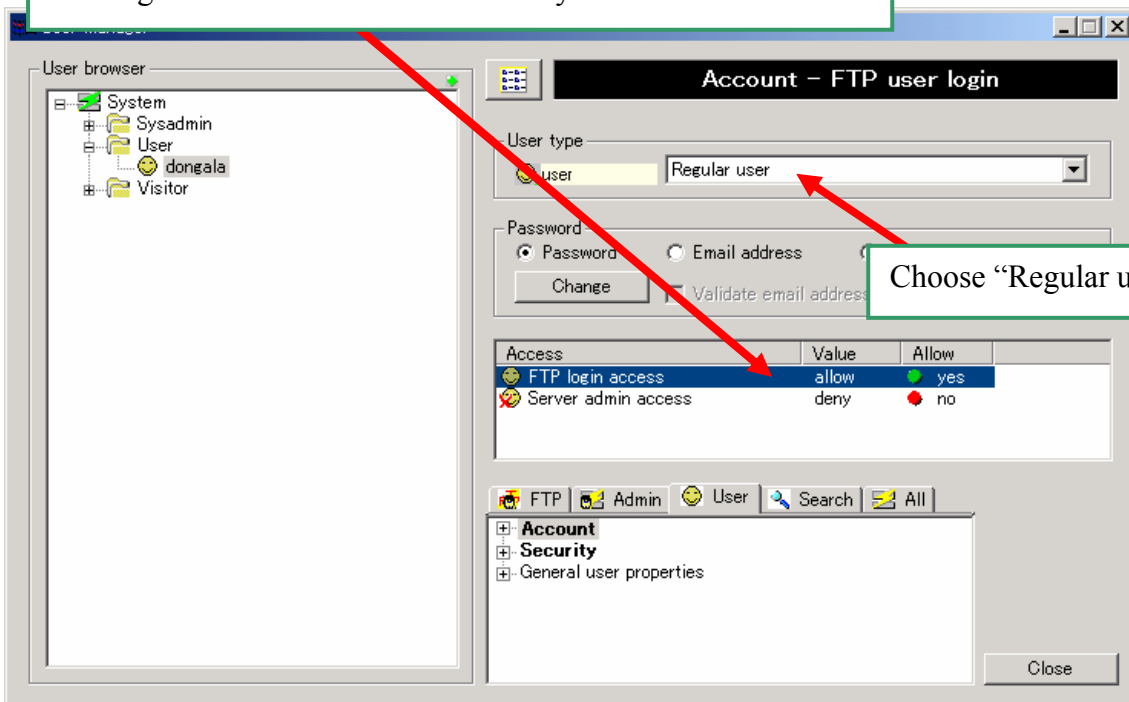


At least make one user ID.



# WarFTP

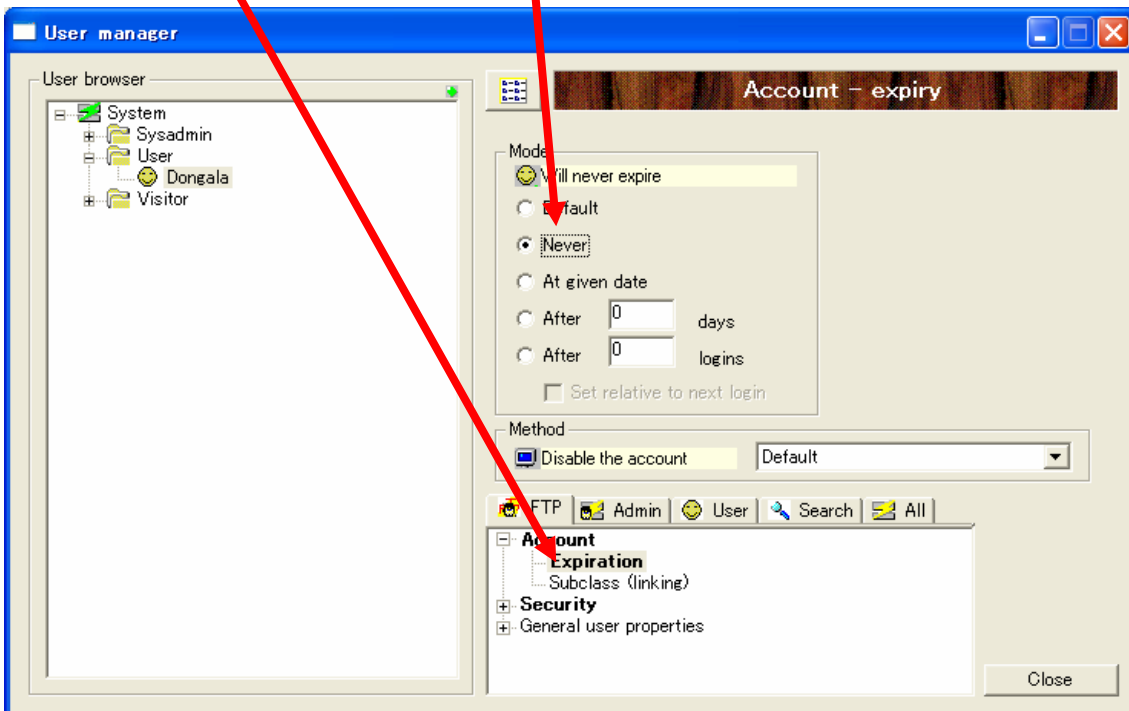
FTP login access should be "allow and yes".



Choose "Regular user".

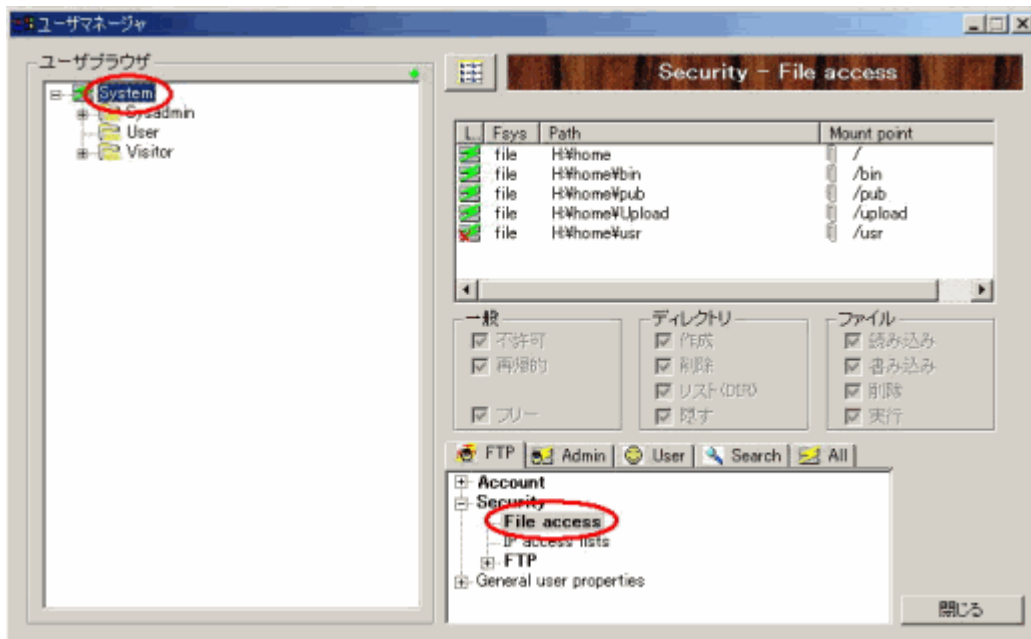
1. Click "Expiration".

2. Select "Never".

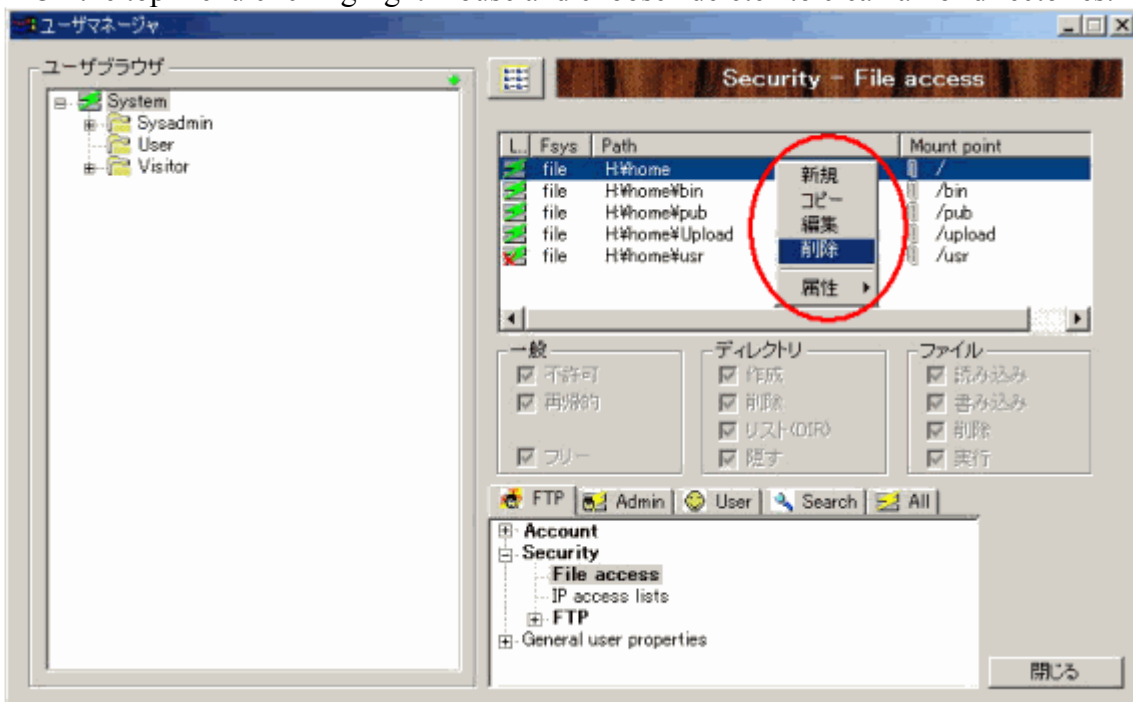


# WarFTP

Now, we are going to delete other directories. On the left of User Browser, point “System” then select “Security” on the right of File access.



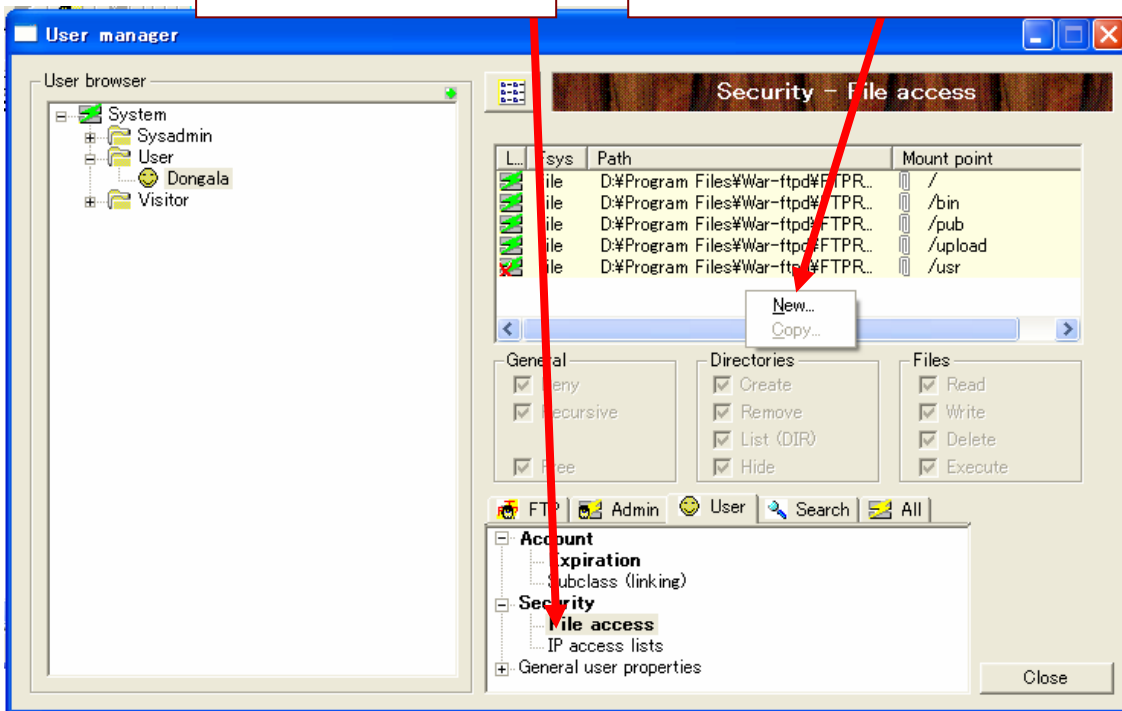
On the top menu clicking right mouse and choose “delete” to clean all of directories.



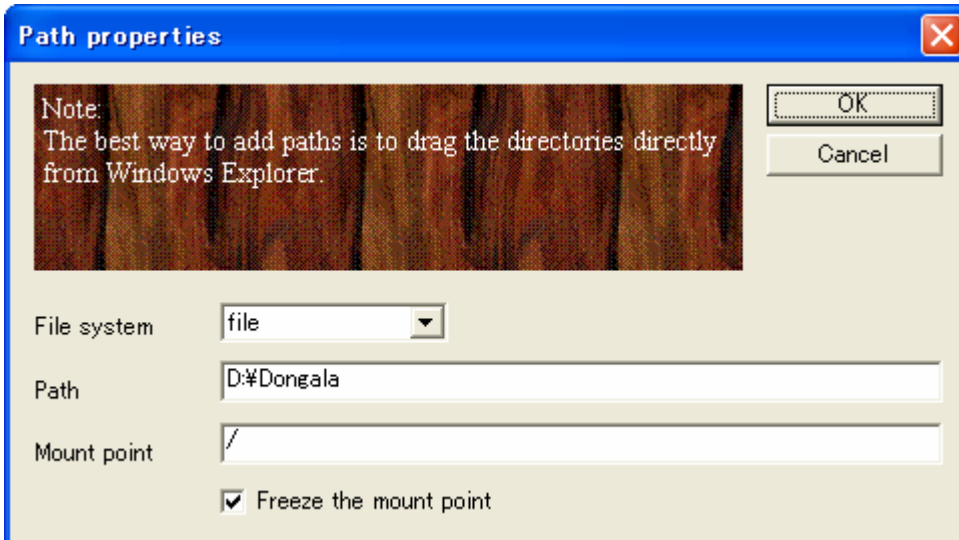
# WarFTP

2. Right click and select "New".

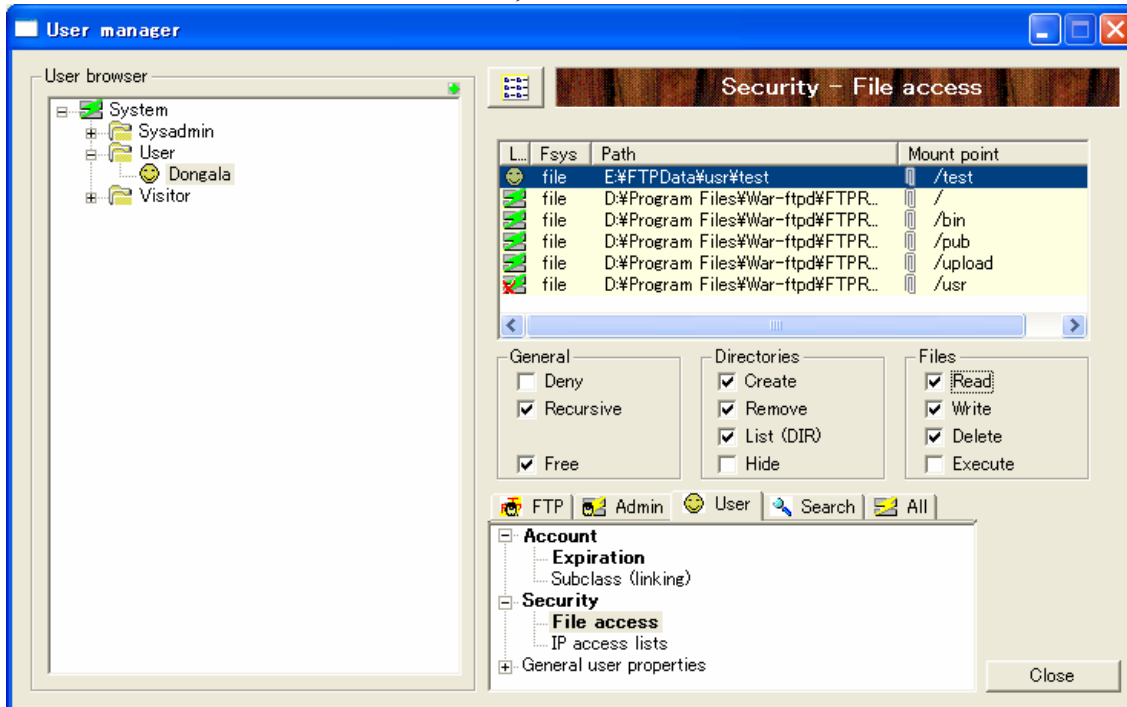


Fill as the below then click OK.
